Dear Mr. Colvin:

The New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (Department) reviewed the information submitted on July 6, 2016 by the Department of the Army. The Department concurs with the Department of the Army that no additional action is necessary for the former gasoline station associated with Building 2541, and all remedial actions are complete. The determination that the remedial action is complete is based upon information in the Department's case file, the report submitted by the Department of the Army, and the certified representations and information provided to the Department.

Additional areas of concern within Parcel 28 that have been addressed:

- Three septic systems designated as "carve-outs"
  - o The three septic systems were granted the designation of no further action necessary on September 22, 2015
- Underground Storage Tanks
  - USTs 2542-29 and 2564-32 granted designation of no further action September 22, 2015
  - UST Building 2546 / T9 the Department agreed to the designation of Category 1 on February 22, 2013

Note, this approval letter specifically does not include the former #2 fuel underground storage tank at Building 2544 / T-7. As previously indicated, the Department cannot comment as to the absence or presence of a petroleum discharge as no evaluation has been performed.
