The New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (Department) has reviewed the July 13, 2012 letter report and applicable portions of the associated *October 2005 Remedial Action Report for the 800, 700 and 400 Areas,* submitted by the Department of the Army. The Department concurs with the Department of the Army that all remedial actions required for remediation of the contamination noted at sample location 800-75, on the eastern portion of Parcel 56, are complete provided that the Department of the Army continues to comply with the conditions referenced below. The determination that the remedial action is complete is based upon information in the Department's case file, the reports submitted by the Department of the Army, and the certified representations and information provided to the Department.

## Conditions:

Pursuant to N.J.S.A. 58:10B-120, the Department of the Army and any other person who was liable for the cleanup and removal costs, and remains liable pursuant to the Spill Act, shall inform the Department in writing within 14 days whenever its name or address changes. Any
