The New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (Department) has completed review of the referenced Response to Departmental Comments dated February 6, 2015, to the *Final Groundwater Sampling Reports for FTMM-22, FTMM-53 and FTMM-68*, received on June 22, 2015. The report is approved.

FTMM-22

Slug tests results were provided for CW1MW29, CW1MW25, CW1MW31 and CW1MW281. While two of the wells were not originally proposed for slug testing, the response is acceptable the Department. The Department required the submittal of analytical results for 1,4-dioxane from the FTMM-22 wells; the results for the seven wells were submitted. Concentrations in all wells were below the GWQS. Additional discussion relative to the slug test and 1,4-dioxane analytical results will be provided in the RI/FS Report for Site FTMM-22. The response is acceptable.

FTMM-53

The submittal indicates lead sampling will be conducted as a separate investigation and will be presented in the RI/FS Report for FTMM-53, as will slug test results for wells 699RW-4 and 699RW-11. The RI investigation is scheduled for the summer of 2015. Monitor wells FTMM53-MW01 and FTMM53-MW02 will be installed and sampled at that time. All information is to be included in the RI/FS Report. The response is acceptable.

FTMM-68

The direct push point investigation (approved in January of 2014) is to be conducted as a separate investigation and will be presented in the RI/FS Report for FTMM-68. The RI investigation is to begin during the summer of 2015. The response is acceptable.
