The New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (Department) has completed review of the referenced Groundwater Sampling Report for FTMM-22, FTMM-53 and FTMM-68, prepared by Parsons, received on July 6, 2016. The Department's comments relative to the submittal are provided below.

As part of the site long-term monitoring plan, a quarterly ground water sampling event was conducted at the three referenced parcels. Sampling methodology utilized passive diffusion bag samplers (PDBS).

FTMM-22 (Lime Pit) – Wells continue to exceed the Ground Water Quality Standards (GWQS) for TCE and vinyl chloride.

FTMM-53 (Former Gas Station) – Wells continue to exceed the GWQS for benzene, 1,2,4-Trimethylbenzene, PCE and VOC TICs.

FTMM-68 (Former Dry Cleaners) – Wells continue to exceed the GWQS for PCE, TCE, cis-1,2-DCE and vinyl chloride.

As approved in March of 2016, future long-term monitoring events are temporarily suspended while the remedial investigations of FTMM-22, FTMM-53 and FTMM-68 are completed.
