Dear Mr. Hacklar:

The US Army Fort Monmouth has completed the interim removal action (IRA) at Building 978 (Parcel 97) in accordance with the approach described in the referenced letter. The IRA was performed by Tetra Tech, Inc. between January 2016 and August 2016. The letter report for the IRA (attached) summarizes the activities completed to remove PCB-impacted soil and concrete as well as the subsequent confirmation sampling activities. As all final confirmation samples indicate that site soils are now below the New Jersey Residential Soil Remediation Standards and Toxic and Controlled Substances Act unrestricted use standards, we request No Further Action for Parcel 97.
