(WESTON®), on behalf of the U.S. Army Fort Monmouth, Directorate of Engineering and Housing (DEH), is pleased to submit these Underground Storage Tank Closure and Site Investigation Reports for waste oil tanks associated with Buildings 750, 161, 1122 and 290. At DEH's request, we have provided one (1) copy of each report for your review.

Following closure, the underground storage tanks (USTs) were transported to ~~Mazza and Sons Inc.~~ ^{Redbank Recycle} for recycling, in compliance with all applicable regulations and laws.
