Re: Out of State Disposal of Non-Hazardous Petroleum Contaminated Soils.


Dear Mr. Kinckle:

The Directorate of Public Works requests approval to dispose of 250 cubic yards of virgin petroleum contaminated soil. Said soils have been classified as non-hazardous waste in accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:26-1,4,7-12 et seq. The analytical results used to characterize the waste soils are enclosed for your review. In addition, the referenced soils are considered Class B recyclable materials as defined by N.J.A.C. 7:26A-1.1 et seq. Petroleum contaminated soils are currently stored in the 2500 area of Fort Monmouth. Soil piles are stored on and covered with polyethylene sheeting. Contaminated (non-hazardous) soils will be sent to an out of state permitted thermal treatment facility. In accordance with NJDEP requirements the following information is provided:
