Dear Mr. Kramer:

This letter is in response to your correspondence dated June 18, 1993 pertaining to the DICAR activities being conducted at the above referenced site. The information contained in your correspondence is accurate except for the following items:

Well Search: Currently Roy F. Weston Inc. is conducting a post wide well search which extends a minimum of 1/4 mile from the perimeter of the facility. The survey is scheduled to be complete by January 1, 1994.


Product Release: The release of product was due to a piping leak which was discovered after daily inventory records indicated a loss of product. The installation of the Phase II Vapor Recovery System was done along with the replacement of all of the product piping.

Fort Monmouth has contracted with The Krydon Group, Engineers and Environmental Scientists NJDEPE Firm Cert. # 0400271, to answer the deficiencies stated in your June 18, 1993 letter. I have enclosed the complete report as a response to your request for further action. Fort Monmouth has completed the soil sampling / analytical activities and is currently pursuing full compliance with the "Cleanup Standards for Contaminated Sites".

In the near future I would like to set up a meeting with you to evaluate and discuss this case as well as the Fort Monmouth Underground Storage Tank Program. Both the NJDEPE and Fort Monmouth would greatly benefit by working together in protecting the environment and ensuring our continued compliance with NJDEPE regulatory requirements.

Mr. Appleby of my office will be contacting you to set up the meeting and discuss this report submission within the following weeks.
