The report is complete and requests "No further action". As required by the NJDEP Technical Regulations (N.J.A.C. 7:26 E), any UST sampled after July, 1997 requires GPS data locations included within the report. This UST was removed September 10, 1997. As with all the UST removals within the Evans Area, as you have directed, electronic deliverables are required. This UST was located within the Parcel E area, which is undergoing a fast-track transfer to Wall Twp. NJ. The assistance of the NJDEP in approving this NFA request now will greatly enhance the speed of property transfer to the local community. Electronic Data Deliverables will be compiled and sent to your office within 2 months.
