The purpose of this letter is to inform you of the work that is being performed on Leonard Avenue. This work consists of cleaning soil contamination from a former underground heating oil tank that existed at the Northeast corner of our Building 277.

On the 1st of October, the south side of Leonard Avenue, nearest the railroad crossing is scheduled to be excavated. Traffic into Horseneck Point may be delayed during the day. A Flagman from NJ Transit will be insuring safety within the work area.

By removing all soils contaminated from the underground storage tank problems of the past we are moving toward a cleaner environment for all to enjoy. Although this road was just recently repaved the contamination has now been determined to exist under the new pavement. After all the contaminated soil is removed the road will be repaired .

We are committed to protecting the natural resources of the area.
