The New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (Department) has completed review of the referenced submittal, received on May 16, 2014. Comments are as follows:

**Page 3 of 8, Section 4.1.1 FTMM-20, Pre-1941 Former Main Post Sanitary Treatment Plant**  
The final sentence indicates an RI report requesting an NFA determination was submitted to the NJDEP in March of 2004. It does not appear, however, the NFA determination was granted, and recent IRP Status submittals from the Army indicate a Remedial Investigation Report requesting a designation of no further action is to be submitted in the near future.

**Page 4 of 8, Section 4.3 Petroleum and Petroleum Products & Enclosure 4**  
No investigative reports have been submitted to demonstrate stated conditions for the majority of the USTs within the subject areas. The exceptions are those USTs indicated as having received a designation of no further action, or closure approval from the Department.

Information regarding the seven suspect fuel USTs in the 300 Area Barracks was provided in the March 2012 Army Response, however, this office responded in July of 2012 that insufficient information had been provided to determine no further action was necessary.
